### **Modernizing local law enforcement and forensic processes with EU support**

***Presently no application is available in Hungary that would comprehensively support forensic expertise; the processes are not harmonized and automated.***

***The iCollWare Kft. has been qualified for support in the framework of the New Hungarian Development Plan GOP 1.2.1. to an information technology research and development project that facilitates cooperation with electronic means between the requester of an expert opinion and the forensic experts and institutions.***

The goal of the R&D project, launched in September 2011 has been to develop a complex framework system horizontally covering the forensic processes, which supports electronically the preparation of a well-founded expert opinion. The system meets special demands of every expert body by harmonizing the ministry's requirements, which manages and supervises this field, and the profession's expectations. Thus it provides an advanced solution for the preparation of expert opinion to the forensic experts and specialist-consultants.

Thanks to the program's modular structure it is applicable in every field of expertise, and the supported activities in a certain special field can be even integrated with other systems as well. In addition, the system will provide opportunities for secondary use of stored data assets, conducting research, generating statistics, and last but not least the standardization of methods, processes and the documentation of expert opinion.

On the basis of the research results, an accurate three-dimensional digital model of the accident or crime scene can be created with the laser scanning survey. Subsequently, the Police, experts and other bodies will be able to explore this result product from any point of view, walk it around or analyse at any stage of the investigation.

The project is expected to end in the middle of 2013, and the emerging complex solution will give an effective tool to the forensic institutes, the Police, state background institutions, companies rendering professional services and university research laboratories to optimise their processes and costs.
